Directions for Audio Geography Center Label Template "OL 991"

- 1. Keep the file in PDF or JPEG format
- 2. The resolution is 150 dpi don't change it!
- 3. Extend any "bleed" past the outside edge of the label
- 4. I've found that labels that rely on the center hole, or outer edge don't come out as planned most of the time.
- 5. Please use less than 50% fill, when white paper is loaded with black ink, it never looks good.
- 6. Return the image to me, without the template lines.
- 7. There are 6 circles on the template, use the left 3 for side A, and the right 3 for side B. If your record is one sided, fill up the whole template please!
- 8. Please return in PDF format, exactly 8.5"x11", 150 DPI.

If you need design help, or any serious editing, we can provide that. There will be a \$20 base fee for any editing or layout work. Additional designing and other considerations may be quoted individually.
